This grounded start has been very helpful in his career. It has enabled José Luis to appreciate the importance of designing rigs that are practical to tour and rig in a venue and also gain the respect of his peers because he can see things from a technical as well as a creative perspective.

José Luis' work encompasses shows and events of all types - from corporate events to live music and theatre / performances. He works extensively throughout Mexico and Central America and also the US.

He was introduced to Robe three years ago by his brother Alejandro who is also a big fan of the brand.

In Mexico currently the most used Robe products are the MMX Spot and LEDWash 600 and 1200s and these also feature in Luis's designs.
